# 1. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

# 2. REVIEW OF BOARD AGENDA

#### 3. BUDGET & FINANCE

Vice Chancellor of Educational Services Topham provided a brief update on the Accreditation Midterm and Mid-cycle Reports. This item is scheduled to be presented to the Board at the March 11<sup>th</sup> Board meeting. There were no questions or concerns raised.

# 6. SPRING 2021 BOARD POLICY AND ADMIN PROCEDURE UPDATE SCHEDULE

Margaret Lamb, Executive Assistant to the Chancellor, brought an updated schedule for the Spring 2021 Board Policies and Administrative Procedures review process for DGC. She explained the three categories of review and promised that sufficient time would be allowed for broad participatory input districtwide.

Margaret Lamb brought the Board Policies and Administrative Procedures for a second review and provided the schedule for Spring 2021. There were no questions or concerns. The items will move forward.

The recommendations will go to the Chancellor for review.
